Cambridgeshire County Netball Association is currently looking for enthusiastic and suitably qualified Volunteer Coaches to complement their County Player Pathway Programme coaching team from September 2022. The expectation is that interested coaches will be seeking mentoring from existing Pathway Coaches with a view to gaining knowledge and experience of the Performance Pathway. We seek experienced minimum, Level 1 qualified coaches who wish to work towards their Level 2 qualification, or current Level 2 coaches looking to coach at a higher level. Coaches would be encouraged to develop their own skills under the guidance of their mentor, working as part of the Performance Pathway team. Initially assisting with the delivery of small sections, coaches would grow in experience and confidence, fast-tracking them towards their Level 2.

- U18 South County Player Development Programme: alternate Mondays school term time, The Perse, Cambridge CB2 8QF (currently 7.30-9.30pm)
- U18 North County Player Development Programme: alternate Thursdays in school term time, Stanground Academy, PE7 3BY (currently 6.30pm-8.30pm)

- Current 'Safeguarding and Protecting Children' Certificate (within last 3 years).
- Evidence of recent attendance at England Netball CPD Workshops.
- Experience and knowledge of delivering coaching sessions to juniors (in an assisting capacity).
- A willingness to learn of the needs of talented young athletes and the ability to communicate well with athletes, parents and coaches in a performance environment.
